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As part of the ESSER III Assurance Statements, the United States Department of Education requires all districts to post their plan for uses of the ESSER III funds on the school website. In order to comply with the USDOE requirement, the following is a list of how the funds will be used.

1. Overton Public School will spend \$55,000 on staff development. The development will include one day of in-service beyond the regular contract days for the school years 2022-2023, 2023-2024, and 2024-2025. We are planning on providing professional development opportunities for all preschool through grade twelve staff members. The focus will include work with the Language Arts, Reading, Mathematics, and other essential curriculum areas. Staff members will be brought in prior to the beginning of school and be paid a stipend.
2. Overton Public School will spend \$107,800 on technology for students and staff. Overton Public Schools is purchasing educational technology (hardware & software) to enhance every students/staff opportunity to participate in remote, hybrid and/or in person models. The technology will also allow students to work at home during evenings and weekends if a face to face environment. The technology will integrate the whole child needs with the academic needs. Ensuring equitable instruction allows the school to consistently meet the social-emotional needs of all students.
3. Overton Public School will spend \$75,770 on new curriculum. The new curriculum will include research-based materials and resources for math, reading and language arts, and science. The new curriculum will be selected from the Nebraska Instructional Materials List.
4. Overton Public School will spend \$140,285 on HVAC improvements. Overton Public Schools is replacing and upgrading existing HVAC units that will improve the air quality in the school. Newer units will increase the air handling ability as well as utilizing better filtering capabilities. We will also replace old carpet with new carpets which will reduce and dust, mold, and help with air quality within each classroom.
